The men's varsity basketball team appointed interim head men's basketball coach, Matt McCullough, as head coach in April 2022. The women's team won the conference crown in February 2022 and basketball coach, JT Lewis was named WPCC Coach of the Year after the Lakers went undefeated versus conference competition. Laker wrestlers were the 2021-2022 Gulf Atlantic District cochampions, with all 9 district entrants qualifying for the national championship tournament.
