# **Garrett Hall**

- Traditional suite-style housing, houses two students per room
- Each room is fully furnished & equipped with a microwave and mini-fridge
- Main floor features a recreation lounge, general kitchen area, vending area, laundry facilities, and mailroom
- Includes Laker Dollars for Laker Café on campus





## Laker Hall

- Offers students two-and fourbedroom apartment-style units
- Features a recreation lounge, tutoring/study lounge, vending machines, laundry facilities, and mailroom
- Each unit is equipped with fully-furnished kitchens, living rooms, and bedrooms
- Handicap accessible and equipped with an elevator
- Students can purchase Laker Dollars for Laker Café on campus



#### As of Fall 2018, students must meet ALL of the NEW HOUSING REQUIREMENTS listed below to be considered for housing:

- Minimum high school GPA of 1.5 (on 4.0 scale)
- Score of 44 or higher on the Classic Accuplacer Reading Comprehension Exam (Next Generation equivalent TBD)
- Final high school transcript on file with GC Admissions Office
- Full application and deposit payment made in order to process your housing application
- Pass background check (includes criminal/court records and social media)
