Application Instructions for Garrett College Foundation Scholarships

Please note: This application must be downloaded, printed and fully completed. It cannot be submitted electronically. Submit paper document(s) to the Office of Student Financial Aid located in the Student Center Building (Room 401).

- ⌘ Scholarships are available to degree seeking applicants who demonstrate financial need as well as academic success.
- ⌘ The Garrett College Foundation application must be completed annually as well as the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Students who are residents of Garrett County and qualify must also apply for the Garrett County Scholarship.
- ⌘ Once an applicant's need has been determined and all other non-loan federal, state and county aid awarded, any unmet need will be used to determine eligibility for Foundation scholarships.
- ⌘ Some Garrett College Foundation programs have additional and/or unique eligibility criteria and will be awarded accordingly.
- ⌘ A recipient must also maintain the required academic status set forth by the Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress rules and any individual scholarship criteria.
- ⌘ Students may begin submitting applications on January 15, 2013 with priority review given to applications that are complete by March 1, 2013. Applications will continue to be accepted until funds are exhausted.
- ⌘ No application will be reviewed unless it is complete with all required documentation.
- ⌘ Students who are awarded these scholarships may be required to submit additional information.
