Court #2209 Announces Scholarship

Information has been released by the Catholic Daughters of the Americas, Court Oakland #2209, of one available scholarship to eligible Catholic women from Garrett County. The Mildred G. Maroney Scholarship is in the amount of \$500.00 for one scholarship to be applied to the 2013-2014 school year. Applications and criteria information will be available through the guidance offices at either Southern Garrett High School or Northern Garrett High School, at the Garrett College Guidance Office, or you may call St. Peter the Apostle Catholic Church office at 301-334-2202.

The eligible student must have a grade point average level no lower than 2.50. A letter of application must be sent from the student describing her academic and career plans, her need and qualifications for the scholarship, and her experiences as a Catholic woman. This letter should be 250 words or less. The scholarship is available to all Garrett County Catholic women who are graduating from high school or returning to college.

The Catholic Daughters award their scholarship on a yearly basis.

Applications for the Mildred G. Maroney Scholarship must be received by June 30th. The Catholic Daughters of the Americas will decide the winner of the scholarship in July and notify the student by July 31st. Checks will be made payable to the college or university. - 1. Must be a Catholic woman from Garrett County.**
 - 2. Must have (3) references – two on academic abilities and achievements and one may be a personal recommendation.**
 - 3. Must have a grade point average level no lower than 2.50. The applicant must have high school/college grades from each year sent to the Scholarship Committee.**
 - 4. Must have a letter from the applicant on the basis of need. This letter should be 250 words or less.**
 - 5. The deadline for applications is June 30th of each year. The Scholarship Committee will choose the winner by committee by July 31st.**
 - 6. The winner will be notified by July 31st from the Scholarship Committee.**
